

Moving towards a better future

Karibu (Welcome) to the 10th edition of the Kenya Association of Hotelkeepers & Caterers (KAHC) Hotel and Restaurant Guide.

On 4 March 2013 Kenya conducted national elections governed by the constitution adopted in 2010 and subsequent parliamentary acts. Kenyans showed a high level of patriotism and togetherness as they came out in large numbers to vote peacefully. A number of peaceful campaigns were rolled out to preach against violent acts as witnessed in the 2007/2008 post elections, and although the results were contested in the Supreme Court, the final results were upheld. Ultimately, citizens made history by electing six offices in one day and maintained peace all the way.



INTERNATIONAL EVENTS

Kenya had the privilege of hosting the African Hotel Investment Forum for the second year running. The event saw the attendance of top-notch international hotel brands. Some of these international brands have shown interest in joining Hilton, InterContinental and Kempinski and have started investing in the country.

We also had the honour of hosting the Ecotourism and Sustainable Tourism Conference in Nairobi. The theme for this year's event was tourism's role in sustainable community development.

The country also hosted the World Travel Awards Africa 2013 in Nairobi. Today, the WTA brand is recognised globally as the ultimate hallmark of quality, with winners setting the benchmark to which all others aspire.

The Kenya government has invested heavily in infrastructure with the aim of improving the country's economic status. Over the next 15 years it will spend KES 7 trillion on road construction. A National Road Sector Investment Plan has been completed and is expected to improve the country's business environment for both domestic and foreign investors. First priority will be given to roads in Nairobi with expansion of some major highways and construction of bypasses under way. A massive infrastructure upgrade is needed if the country is to get to the envisioned economic status by 2030.

SUCCESSSES

The hospitality fraternity takes this opportunity to salute our Kenyan athletes for their brilliant performance at the 14th edition of the IAAF World Championships in Moscow. Kenya managed to retain its title as Africa's best. We were ranked fourth in the world behind Russia, the USA and Jamaica.

This year was an important one for Kenya as we celebrated 50 years of independence. This is an opportunity for Kenya to showcase its achievements and celebrate nationhood. It's a fresh spring leading to a better future.

Our role as a member association, with a strict code of ethics, continues to be felt in all spheres. We have experienced an increased membership base and we take this opportunity to welcome those who are making their first appearance in the Guide.

The Kenya Hotel & Restaurant Guide continues to highlight the best of the best.

ABILITY



destination of choice, the nation's safaris businesses reap the rewards of Kenya Tourism Board's marketing drive and tourists return in greater numbers to the coast.

Nairobi's hotel capacity continues to grow with new properties opening and with more in the pipeline.

ON THE RISE

The small camps and lodges that form the backbone of the safari sector are also on the rise – even in areas such as the Masai Mara and where it might be thought that saturation point had been reached. The vast majority of these new camps and lodges are at the exclusive end of the market.

The coast, meanwhile, remains reliant on air charters. More scheduled flights are operating into Mombasa and the upgrade of Malindi Airport is under consideration, so this over-reliance

on non-scheduled airlines may become a thing of the past.

But Kenya remains a vibrant and resilient destination with accommodation and service to match. It's part of the KAHC's raison d'être to ensure that this is indeed the case.



Capital of contrasts has unrivalled appeal



If Nairobi has a rival as Africa's most appealing city then it's one that is difficult to find. No other city across the continent can match the Kenyan capital in terms of location, climate, connectivity, hotel accommodation, closeness to wildlife and a general sense of joie de vivre.

Of course, some things still need to be improved. But many of its shortcomings are being addressed. As each year passes the quality life in Nairobi gets that little bit better while reinforcing its position as East Africa's commercial capital. The regional headquarters of the United Nations (the third-largest such office worldwide), the World Bank and commercial giants such as Coca-Cola are all based in Nairobi.

Moreover, Kenya's mile-high capital is the number one choice for continent-wide exhibitions and conferences.

No matter how important a city is from the business perspective, however, it needs at least two other ingredients to be truly successful in attracting visitors: sufficient hotel accommodation and an international airport with strong global connections. Nairobi has both.

AMBITIOUS

This was not always the case, but over the past five years the city has seen a welcome explosion in bed capacity, while national carrier Kenya Airways



has embarked on an ambitious route expansion programme aimed at linking Nairobi with all other African capitals. Foreign airlines, too, are beating a path to Nairobi's door.

Thankfully the days when visiting conference attendees would be forced to rent apartment or 'double up' at hotels during major gatherings are a thing of the past. Today, Nairobi can rightly claim that the city has sufficient hotel capacity to handle any major international event and with a range of accommodation to suit all budgets.

If a trend is emerging, then Nairobi is seeing clusters of hotels in certain parts of the city. Where once the city centre dominated with its Serena, Hilton, Nairobi Safari Club, The Norfolk, Inter-Continental and Laico Grand Regency, this pre-eminence is now being rivalled by other areas such as Westlands, Upper Hill and Mombasa Road.

Upmarket Westlands, with its shops, bars and restaurants, remains popular with business visitors (and Jacaranda, Sankara and Southern Sun are the dominant properties in this area). The opening in 2013 of the 200-room

Villa Rosa Kempinski will further enhance this area west of Museum Hill.

Upper Hill, meanwhile, has become the focus for much of the city recent high-rise office development (the Coca-Cola office is here) and hotels are also starting to spring up. First the Crowne Plaza and soon to be followed in late 2014 by the new Radisson Blu Nairobi

ALTERNATIVE

Karen, too, is emerging as a tranquil alternative to the city for both business and leisure visitors. The opening in 2013 of the boutique 45-room Hemingways Nairobi has given the leafy suburb new dimension.

In addition to its role as a commercial centre, Nairobi remains the start and finish point for many safaris. Many of these visitors are seeking mid-range properties such as the recently opened 96-room Best Western Premier in Hurlingham; and here, too, Nairobi has moved to satisfy demand and the trend towards more airport-based hotels continues with the Panari, Ole-Sereni, recently completed The Boma and Eka Hotel, all competing for business from clients who do not wish to travel into the city after arriving at Jomo Kenyatta Airport.

Despite the many new hotels and the upgrading of many existing properties, there seems no let-up in the construction. So expect to see more new hotels – some from the industry's top players – on the horizon. This should ensure that Nairobi maintains its position as Africa's place to do business and as the perfect start and finish point for a safari.



Enduring appeal of the coast

There's no denying it. It has been a tough couple of years at the coast for the vitally important tourism sector, but this has not dampened the enthusiasm of local hoteliers who are now seeing a long-awaited resurgence in visitor numbers.

Heavily dependent on regular air charters from Europe, the coast has traditionally been at the mercy of decisions made far away. This is slowly changing due to growing local affluence as more and more Kenyans take vacations at the coast, together with an increase in independent travellers, especially at the top and bottom ends of the market.

As in the past, problems in 2013 impacting competitor destinations have helped increase the number of visitors to the Kenyan coast – and what a coast it is. In fact, Kenya has a coastline stretching 450 km from north to south and most of this beautiful coastline is made up of soft, sandy and often deserted beaches.

The coast continues to move upmarket and new hotels are of a high standard, as are the facilities, the most obvious example being the impressive Vipingo Ridge Golf Club.

There are four main resort areas: Mombasa (north and south coast), Malindi and Watamu with, perhaps, Kilifi as an associate member of this group. Each has its attractions:




MOMBASA (NORTH COAST):

This area comprises Nyali, Bamburi, Shanzu all the way up to Mtwapa with its delightful creek. This is the coast's most heavily developed section and contains some of its longest established hotels. This area is also the closest to Mombasa's Moi International Airport.

MOMBASA (SOUTH COAST):

This area is less developed than the north coast, less easy to access but more than worth the effort in getting to the main resort at Diani. But despite some challenges associated with the ferry, those who visit the south coast are always delighted with what they find once in Diani. Here is a safe and relaxed environment with good shops, a choice of restaurants and one or two excellent beach bars.

Hoteliers still await improved road links to Moi International Airport, which currently leaves them vulnerable to disruptions in the Likoni ferry service. Flights from Nairobi to the south coast's own airstrip at Ukunda is one way of avoiding the ferry, another is to take the very short flight from Ukunda to Moi.





MALINDI:

Always popular with Italian visitors, Malindi remains one of the coast's most buoyant resorts and one of its most sophisticated. Led by the huge investment by Italian Flavio Briatore and his new resort. Briatore already owns the boutique Lion in the Sun, but this development is on a different level.


Malindi also expects to gain once its airport is expanded to take international flights. At present, it is restricted to domestic operations. This means that visitors to the resort must transit via Nairobi or take a long bus ride from Mombasa.

WATAMU:

Just 40 minutes to the south, and also reliant on Malindi Airport, is Watamu, a resort gaining in popularity and offering a good selection of hotels to suit a range of budgets.

A mention must also be given to Kilifi. This truly wonderful coastal town remains underdeveloped but has some of the best beaches on the coast and, arguably, its most beautiful creek.

For great value, a broad range of hotels, delicious seafood, attentive service and a year-round climate that few can match, the Kenyan coast really is one of the world's truly great destinations – either on its own or combined with a safari.
