**GUIDANCE FOR KENYAN NATIONALS IN ITALY FOLLOWING THE
OUTBREAK OF CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19)**

In view of the drastic spike of cases of COVID 19 in Italy and the consequent decision by the Italian Government to put the whole country on a lockdown as part of containment measures to limit the spread of the virus, the Embassy wishes to inform Kenyans as follows;

1. The health, welfare and safety of Kenyans living in Italy remains a top priority and concern for the Embassy and the Government of Kenya. A Crisis Management Committee has been set up to closely monitor the spread of the Corona virus, and advice on the impact of this situation to Kenyans at home and abroad.
2. The Embassy therefore wishes to call on all our Diaspora to remain vigilant and take the precautionary measures provided by the Government of Italy and the World Health Organization (WHO).
