NEW PROTOCOLS FOR AIR TRAVEL OPERATIONS FROM THE MINISTRY OF TRANSPORT, INFRASTRUCTURE, HOUSING AND PUBLIC WORKS OF THE REPUBLIC OF KENYA

The Embassy of Kenya in Rome, wishes to draw your attention to the following documents on air travel operations, following the opening of the Kenyan airspace on 1st August 2020;

- 1. Protocols on air travel from the Ministry of Transport, Infrastructure, Housing, Urban Development and Public Works;
- 2. Communique on the resumption of international air travel issued on 1st August 2020. This communique should be read together with the official protocols. It is noted for general information that the list of countries and other guidelines may change from time to time as the situation unfolds;
- 3. Directives on resumption of international flights issued by the Kenya Civil Aviation Authority;
- 4. Gazette notice on the wearing of masks

IMPORTANT NOTICE: The Government wishes to clarify that the Communique issued on 1st August 2020, DOES NOT bar travellers from any country from entering Kenya. However, they will be required to go into mandatory or self-quarantine, whichever is applicable if they are not arriving from any of the countries listed in the Communique.
