NOTICE ON IEBC REGISTRATION OF DIASPORA VOTERS AT THE KENYA EMBASSY BERLIN-GERMANY

Fellow Kenyans,

1. The **Kenya Embassy in Rome** wishes to inform that the Independent Electoral and Boundaries Commission (IEBC) shall conduct Diaspora Voter Registration exercise at the Kenya Embassy Berlin-Germany as from the **Friday, 21st January 2022 until Friday, 4th February 2022** during **official working hours, Monday to Friday: 9:00 a.m. – 13.00 p.m. and from 14:00 p.m. – 17:00 p.m.**, in strict adherence to Covid -19 protocols (**full vaccination and current rapid test**)
2. Kenyans who reside within the European Union (EU) and wish to register to vote in the general elections must fulfil the following conditions:
 - a). **Be in possession of a valid Kenyan passport, (date of validity, not passport type)**
 - b). **Be eighteen (18) years of age and above, and**
 - c). **Present their identification document to the registration officer stationed at the embassy.**
3. The exercise will be conducted by officers from IEBC and the Embassy's role is purely facilitative.
4. The address of the Embassy is **Rheinbabenallee 49, 14199 Berlin.**
5. Public transportation to the embassy is as follows: -
 - 5.1 **Bus 110: Platz am Wilden Eber**
 - 4.2 **Train U3: Podbielskiallee**
6. During the exercise, voters previously registered in Kenya will have to change their voting station to Berlin.
7. Please note that voters registered in the Diaspora will **ONLY** vote for the Presidential elective position.
